- 2. Example 2: Has completed 5 speeches


Your choices:

- A unique evaluation resource for each project that can be completed and stored electronically

- Full-color, professionally bound materials
- Standard shipping (with applicable fees)




Entering Pathways: The Navigator

Entering Pathways: Choose Your Path




- Choose a path

Entering Pathways: Access My Path




- Select your club, then click Log in as a Member
- If you are a VPE, President, or Secretary, your Access tile looks like this (you can act as a Base Camp Manager)




Entering Pathways: Basecamp Home

The first time you enter Base Camp you will get a tour:












Notice that you cannot see the other projects until you complete the Ice Breaker.




Activate changes to Launch. Click Launch.




You will get a new window:



- When you click Begin, you will get a Navigation page that shows you how to move around in the project
- You will get an Assess your Skills Before set of questions. BE SURE TO CLICK SUBMIT after answering the questions.



- Give your Ice Breaker speech at your club
- ▶ (How you treat your Evaluation will be covered later.)
- ▶ Then answer the Assess Your Skills After questions. Once again, BE SURE TO CLICK SUBMIT after answering the questions.
- You will then get a CONGRATULATIONS! page.
- Your Ice Breaker project will show as being completed (white check mark in brown circle), and you will have access to the other two projects:




Level 1 – Evaluation and Research Projects

- For the Evaluation project:
 - 1. Give a 5 7 minute speech on any topic
 - 2. Receive an evaluation
 - 3. Give another 5 7 minute speech, either repeating the same speech or giving a different speech, incorporating the opportunities for improvement suggested by your evaluator. (Have the same evaluator for the second speech.)
- For the Research project:
 - Research a topic of interest to you and give a 5 7 minute speech about it

Level 2



Before you complete Level 1, you can see the projects in Level 2, but not access any details



Level 1 – Completion

Use the Level 1 Completion item to request your Base Camp Manager to verify that you have completed Level 1.

Note to Base Camp Managers: An email is sent to the email on record for the club. You can set this in Club Central.



Level 1 Completion—Team Collaboration

Use this resource to help you through the process of requesting that your Base
Camp manager approve your completion of Team Collaboration Level 1.

You will then have access to the Level 2 Projects.

Evaluations

- An Evaluation document must be downloaded; there is no way to fill one out online.
- Options for how the evaluator may fill out the Evaluation form:
 - 1. Print out the form and write on it
 - 2. Fill out the PDF document on a computer or tablet
- The speaker may upload
 - 1. A filled-out PDF document
 - 2. A scan of a written evaluation
 - 3. A photo of a written evaluation

Evaluations – Where are They?

On the lower half of the page, every project is listed in alphabetical order. Click the project title to get a downloadable evaluation resource in PDF format. Any member may download an evaluation for any project.

Evaluations – 3


- There is no requirement that an evaluation be uploaded.
- Evaluations may be saved in your Base Camp documents folder.

Here is where you see Feedback and badges given to you.




Then select E-portfolio

Then click the Add File button.







Base Camp Managers

The VP Education of the club is the primary Base Camp Manager. Other officers with BCM privileges are President and Secretary.

The responsibilities of a Base Camp Manager are:

- Track speeches given (speeches are not tracked in Base Camp)
- Verify level completion
- Approve outside-the-club projects
- Verify outside-the-club project completion
- Track member progress
- Award badges and certificates
